Audio Bible Ministry receives \$100,000 to expand reach of mobile Bible apps

Colorado Springs, CO – Counsel & Capital (“C&C”), a non-profit organization focused on building bridges of trust and accountability between ‘left-brain’ donors and Christian ministries, announced today that they have selected Faith Comes By Hearing (“FCBH”) to receive their 2010 Ministry Award. The Digital Bible Project – which includes the world's largest collection of digital Scripture – makes Bible text and audio freely accessible to individuals and organizations around the world through the Internet, mobile devices, social networks, and smartphone apps like Bible.is.

“Counsel & Capital is pleased to announce Faith Comes By Hearing as our 2010 Ministry Award recipient,” said Jeannie Cox, spokesperson for C&C. “This project compellingly uses cutting-edge technology and effectively applies a proven Biblical model in pursuit of a meaningful goal.”
